Recent cases and notable legal developments

HU Identification of clients via Skype

Earlier this year, the Act on the Legal Profession enabled lawyers to countersign documents if a client who is not present physically has confirmed his or her signature by means of an audio-video transmitting and recording device. This method is only possible if the countersigning lawyer previously identified the client.

While the Act on the Legal Profession does not require natural persons to be physically present during the identification process, in matters regulated by the Act on the Prevention of Money Laundering and Financing Terrorism, this will only be allowed with the permission of the competent Bar Association.

The Budapest Bar Association thus decided to introduce a more efficient way of identifying clients, allowing lawyers to use videophones for this purpose (Skype version 8 is highly recommended), with the obligation to keep a recording of the material.

An amendment to the Pharmacy Law no. 266/2008 newly allows the sale of OTC medicines via the internet. Only authorized pharmacies are allowed to perform this activity, in conditions which are to be detailed in a future order to be issued by the Ministry of Health.

BG News on renewable energy

Certain amendments in the Bulgarian Energy Act and the Rules on Trading with Electricity that will affect all power plants using renewable energy and co-generation with installed capacity of 4 MW and higher were recently passed. The current regulated price model is being replaced with a free price model and affected procedures will sell their output energy directly or indirectly to the Independent Bulgarian Energy Exchange. Currently effective Power Purchase Agreements will be terminated and replaced with Feed-in-Premium contracts to be signed between the affected producers and the Energy Security Fund. The amendments aim to partially liberalise the energy market in Bulgaria by changing the mechanism for the purchase of electricity from RES producers.
